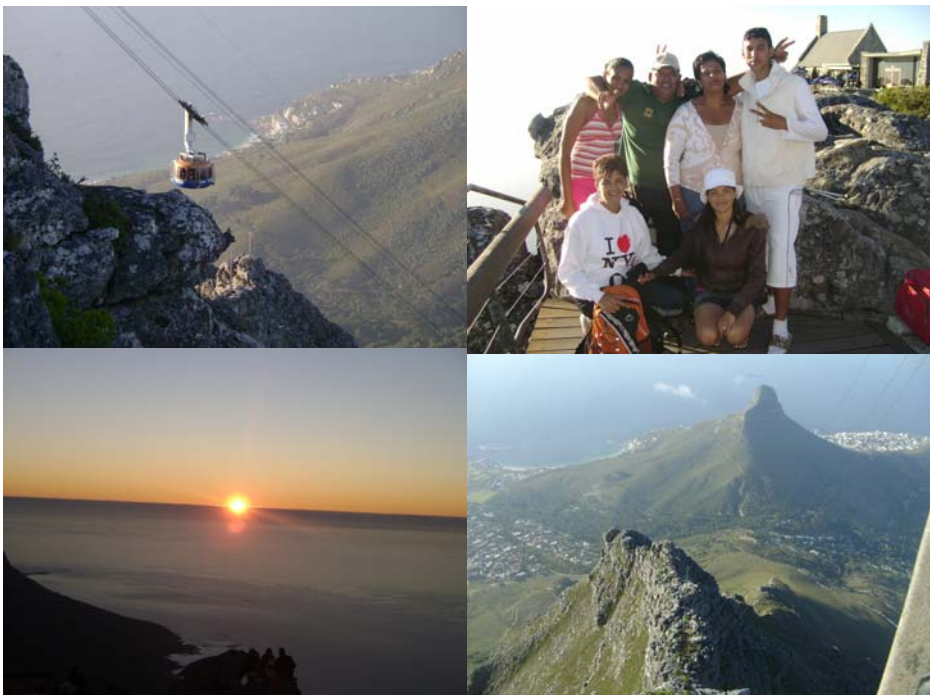


## END OF 2009 ACTIVITIES
